### Gift Aid Notes

1. You may cancel this declaration at any time by notifying us.
2. You must pay an amount of income/capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the Charity reclaims on your donations in the tax year. (If your tax paid falls in the future you can cancel this declaration). Higher rate taxpayers can claim further tax relief on the Self Assessment tax return.
3. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask us, or ask your local tax office for leaflets IR113Gift Aid.
4. For a married couple, the taxpayer should sign the declaration.
5. Claims are not permissible on donations where tax has already been claimed. e.g. CAF cheques.
